- A diploma in Assaying, a degree in Chemistry or a related chemistry based field.
- BC Assayer Certification is desired.

- Previous +2 years' experience working in an analytical laboratory preparing bulk samples and using equipment such as Leco, AA, XRF instrumentation, and wet chemistry
