- Integrated role in short term and long term planning, budgeting and execution for the development of the Tailings Management Facility
- Daily supervision of the operations team associated with the safe construction and management of the TMF
- Integrated role in the Water Management Plan associated with the mill and TMF,
- Integrated into the Mill Department to provide support and coordination when required for department wide projects such as, but not limited to, mill shutdowns
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to deal effectively with operators and tradespeople
- Demonstrated history of safe work habits
- Other duties as assigned

- Degree in Metallurgy, Chemical Engineering, Mining, Mineral Processing, or related geoscience engineering to Tailings Management
- A minimum of 5-7 years' experience in concentrators, including significant time spent managing tailings storage facilities
- Hold or is able to obtain a Professional Engineering designation in British Columbia within 6 months
- Able to effectively communicate both verbally and in writing
- High degree of resourcefulness, flexibility, and adaptability
- Valid driver's license
- Ensures compliance with all applicable safety and environmental regulations, company policies and standards
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills.
