ABOUT THE ROLE

The Environment Manager reports directly to the General Manager of Eva Copper and is responsible for leading activities related to environmental management and permitting requirements for the mine. - Establish positive working relationships with government and regulatory agencies, community groups, traditional owners, and other key stakeholders.
- Obtaining environmental approvals, permits and authorisations required for the mine development.
- Raise environmental awareness amongst all employees and contractors and monitor activities.
- Monitor and report on environmental compliance during construction and operations.
- Attend business and community events and collaborate with industry associations to represent Copper Mountain's interests and support the industry.

- Exceptional attention to detail, strong business acumen and ability to contribute to the strategic review and planning processes with the leadership team.
