- Provides high system availability,
- Builds relationships with IT services vendors and works closely with the site on IT projects,
- Configures and maintains FortiGate firewalls, Rules, Routes, NAT, and VPNs,
- Acquires, sets up, and maintains new workstations and servers,
- Arranges and maintains remote support for critical 24X7 systems,
- Maintains expertise in current and evolving technologies, recommends and implements new technologies,

- Keeps the ERP and asset management system,
- Delivers end-user and desktop support both remotely and onsite,
- Performs any other responsibilities related to the IT Specialist role as required or as assigned by the department head.
